I am the Mental Health and Wellbeing Leader which is a new role that is being rolled out in primary schools in our area this year. I have previously taught at Launching Place Primary School for 12 years and loved being part of the school

community. I have taught Prep, Grade 1/2 and Grade 5/6 as well as being the PE teacher and more recently one term teaching Japanese. I have also worked as a support worker in disability and in education support in a special school and a school in a remote Indigenous community. I am so excited about this new role at KCPS and am passionate about student mental health and wellbeing.

I am a mum to two beautiful boys, Fletcher and Reuben. Fletcher is 3 and is absolutely loving imaginative play at the moment. My Saturday mornings often include rescuing whales, going to space in a rocket ship and driving cars, all in our cosy lounge room. Reuben has just turned 1, he is just starting to walk, loves to play with anything Fletcher is playing with and has the best smile. My husband is Joel, he is a Mental Health Social worker, working two days in private practice work and three days at a high school.

I will be developing and overseeing whole school practices around student mental health and wellbeing, taking our Respectful Relationships classes and small groups sessions with a focus on social and emotional skills. I will be available to assist families to access external services should you need extra support in the mental health and wellbeing area.
