Curriculum Day

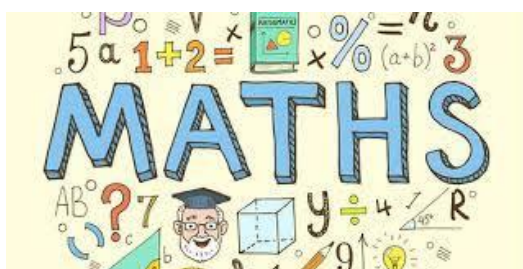
